The section will be split into **seniors** (over 17 years old) and **juniors** (under 17 old). Please state on the entry form which section you are eligible for.

## Rules

- The event will be run under Riding Club Rules
- This event is designed to be a fun and safe introduction to eventing for novice or nervous combinations and as such the show jumping and cross country will not be timed.
- If you are eliminated on cross country please move onto the next fence. If a rider is coming up behind you please stand clear of the fence and the course and continue when the oncoming rider has successfully negotiated and moved on from the fence.
- Hats to BS PAS 015/BSEN 1384 must be worn at all times when mounted. Body protectors are recommended for the show jumping phase. Armbands and body protectors are compulsory for cross country phase.
- If any competitor is eliminated show jumping (unless on a technicality), they may not continue onto cross country.
- The organiser will not be held responsible for any accident or damage to competitors, horses, spectators or vehicles however caused.
- The course will be open for walking from 2pm on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> August.
- The practice fences for show jumping will be supervised so that no competitor can jump any higher than 5cm bigger than the maximum height of the class.
- Dressage: If a bit other than those permitted under BE rules is used 10 penalties will be added; if a martingale is used 10 penalties will be added, if the test is called, 5 penalties will be added. A whip may be carried in the dressage.
- SJ/XC may be led but 5 penalties will be added per phase which is led.
- Numbers will be provided on the day for all competitors.
- Withdrawals are to be notified by Monday 16<sup>th</sup> August and will only be refunded if we can replace you from the wait list.
- There will be an experienced BE rider available should you require any help or have any queries on the day. Course walks will be available but please call to book.

## Lesson prices

From the 1<sup>st</sup> of August 2010 we are going to put the flatwork lesson prices up to £10 per person. We have not had price increase for flatwork for a number of years, but unfortunately the time has come! This falls in line with the cost of our show jumping lessons which, along with the clinic prices, will remain the same.

This is for a number of reasons. The instructors we use have put their prices up over the years and we have not, we still have to pay for some arena hire and we allow the lesson to run without maximum of 4 in a group. We have paid out over £800 in subsidies in the last 6 months to cover the cost of flatwork lessons which means more fundraising for us!

We do not want to make money from our lessons, but we simply can't afford to subsidise to the extent we have. We are still very much cheaper than other riding clubs in our area and believe we still give very good value for money.

We hope you understand the reasoning and continue to book lots of lessons to enjoy. This of course does mean that any vouchers earned from helping at our events will be worth £10 instead of £7 - a definite plus point!

### Show Jumping Lessons

Along side our normal Show Jumping lessons some of our instructors are now running a few different formats to their lessons to give a bit more variety and also to help balance out the abilities in some of our group lessons. So you will now see some of our Show Jumping lessons categorised as the following;

**Jumping with Confidence:** Lessons for nervous riders and green/young horses. Lesson formats will include pole work and simple jumping exercises over small jumps to encourage horse and rider confidence.

**Higher Jumping:** Lessons for more experienced horses and riders who are happy jumping 2'6 and above

**Course Jumping:** Lessons are specifically for Show Jumping course practice. After a warm up courses will be set out and at the height you are happy to jump and our qualified/experienced Show Jumping instructor will be on hand to give you all the pointers and encouragement that you need to get those clear rounds

**Gridwork:** These lessons will be based around Gridwork and Gymnastic jumping exercises to encourage horses balance, rhythm and impulsion. They are also excellent for the riders too!

**Simulated XC:** Use of show jumps in an arena environment to give riders and horses the chance to have a go and practice some of the more technical style XC fences in a safe controlled arena environment.

If you book a lesson, you are expected to show up. If you can't make it, please contact whoever you booked the lesson with and NOT the instructors. If you fail to show up, you WILL be charged. Please text or email us, we might just be able to fill your space. Please be considerate.
