Senior and Junior Team Novice Winter Show Jumping **Area 12 Team Championships and BRC Team Qualifier**

Teams of 4, best 3 scores to count.

This is a team competition only, however individuals can enter but there will be no jump off or placing for individual entries.

Height not to exceed 80cms in first round and 85cms in second round.

If a winner has not been decided after 2nd round then a jump off will take place for all double clear teams or to decide the winner if scores are tied.

Entry fees: £22.00 per horse/rider combination

(This can either be paid in full or BMRC will subsidise half your entry in return for at least 4 hours help at a 2012 BMRC event. Please indicate on entry form)

Please read the following before entering:-


- All communication will be by email – please use an address you check regularly!
- Please check your eligibility for each class.
- Please ensure that you send a copy of your horse's passport with your entry and that you bring it with you on the day. This must be handed in BEFORE you are given your number. A member of BMRC will facilitate this on the day and more details will be emailed prior to the event.
- Entry fees must accompany entry forms – entries without payment will be placed on a wait list until correct payment is received.
- Copies of passport with flu vaccination record must accompany entry forms.
- All teams will be put together on a first come first served basis.
- Please familiarise yourself with the BRC flu vaccination requirements; if your vaccination record is incorrect and your entry becomes a non-qualifier, we will ask for payment from you for the rest of your subsidised entry). IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE THIS IS CORRECT. Link to online flu vaccination checker and the relevant sections of the rulebook:

- A Horse/pony may compete from 1st January in the year it becomes 5 years old.
- Competitors are requested not to leave litter or muck out horse boxes in the lorry park
