

Rules

1. The competition will be run strictly under British Riding Club rules 2012. Please note: these rules come into effect on the 01/01/12
2. **ALL HORSES/PONIES ENTERED FOR BRC QUALIFIERS MUST HAVE A VACCINATION RECORD COMPLYING WITH BRC RULES, THIS RECORD AND PASSPORT MUST BE BROUGHT ON THE DAY OF THE COMPETITION AND A COPY SUBMITTED WITH THE AREA ENTRY. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CLUBS TO ENSURE THESE ARE CORRECT. THE RECORDS OF THE 1ST AND 2ND PLACED QUALIFYING TEAMS/INDIVIDUALS WILL BE CHECKED BEFORE THE PRIZE GIVING. ANY INCORRECT RECORDS WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.**
3. Entries close on **Tuesday 20th March 2012**
4. Entries will not be accepted without the correct entry fees. Cheques should be made payable to Area 12.
5. In the event of withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of entries.
6. Hats up to current standards with 3 point restraining harness **MUST** be worn and fastened at all times when mounted. See note on hat tagging.
7. BRC Health and Safety guidelines apply at all times. For these to be effective, competitors and spectators are required to take due care at all times and to obey any notices or requests made by official stewards in the interests of their own and others safety.
8. Neither BRC Area 12 or Cannington Equestrian will hold themselves responsible for any accident to persons, property and/or horses. By entering this competition, competitors accept the risks involved in horse riding and competing.
9. The judges decision is FINAL
10. **ONLY** persons and/or horses competing may use the warm up facilities at Cannington.
11. Competitors are requested not to leave litter or muck out horse boxes in the box park
12. Horses must not be tied to horseboxes or trailers or left unattended
13. All ridden horses/ponies must be 4 yrs or over
14. Objections to be made to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the end of the class and accompanied by a £10 deposit
15. All persons attending the show will be deemed to have accepted the rules and conditions

The competition will consist of an Area Qualifier and the final to be held at RWHS.

Note Vaccination rules for qualifying entries. Any incorrect vaccination record will result in disqualification of the whole team from the qualifier.

Times will be available on the Area 12 website (www.brcaarea12.org.uk) on Thursday 22nd March or from 01934 811816 between 7 and 8pm on Friday 23rd.

ENTRY FEE £10 per class for BRC members. £12 per class for non BRC members.

All cheques should be made payable to Area 12 and have the name of the rider and horse printed clearly on the reverse side. A charge of £10 will be made for any dishonoured cheques.

LOCATION: Turn right at the war memorial in Cannington as if you were going to Stockland Lovell. From the war memorial up the hill about ¼ mile the entrance will be on the right and sign posted golf course and equestrian centre. Keep following the road round the edge of the golf course and it will take you to the equestrian centre.

The warm up will be indoors and the test will be held in the outdoor arena so space will be at a premium for the warm up. Please ride responsibly and make sure you are up to date with your arena etiquette.

Cannington recently replaced the surface in the indoor and outdoor arena.

Class 1 – Warm up class
Prelim dressage test 4 (2002)

Sections will be split into Juniors & Seniors depending on entries.

Rosettes 1st – 6th.

Class 2- RWHS Qualifier
Prelim dressage test 12 (2005) (Junior & Senior)

Rosettes 1st – 6th

- One rider from each dressage class of up to 12 starters will qualify, two will qualify if 13 or more starters in the class.
- Dressage Tests – Prelim 12 at Area Qualifier and Prelim 18 at RWHS.
- BRC general rules and specific rules for dressage will apply.
- The Championship will take place at Royal Windsor Horse Show.
- Horses and ponies may only compete in one section. BRC downgrading rules apply to this competition.
- Qualification - Riders who qualify at the Area Qualifier will be given a qualification card which will be signed by the Area Steward officiating at the Area Qualifier. This qualification card must accompany the entry for the championships at RWHS.
- Each rider must be a member of an affiliated BRC club in the local area to take part in the Area Qualifier.
