

## BLACKDOWN MENDIP RIDING CLUB CAMP Stockland Lovell E.C. 5<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> October 2018

All the facilities at Stockland Lovell - all weather arenas, cross country course, stables, tack room, cabins and showers - have been booked for Riding Club use  $5^{th} - 7^{th}$  October 2018. All meals from Friday supper to Sunday lunch are provided. For more details and directions please see their website: www.stocklandlovell.com We ask you to leave your dog at home please.

**INSTRUCTION** will incorporate flatwork, show jump and cross country training, with the possibility of other options. We have brilliant instructors for you for the weekend – Clare Loney, Anna Gallie and Alaina Webster. If you do not want to take part in a particular discipline, please make us aware so we can try and accommodate another session, however we make no promises.

**COST £210** this includes all meals, tuition, stable with shavings and full use of facilities. **£110** for non-riders, **£155** for hacking guests. Stockland have no facilities for any extra horse unless the full fee is paid.

Both hacking and any extra horses to be discussed individually with Kim prior to booking. Stockland have recently made several upgrades to their facilities, hence the rise in price, but the camp still offers remarkably good value for money.

**HORSE FLU VACS** – Stockland require all horses to have a valid passport showing up to date flu vacs to RC standard – http://www.bhs.org.uk/~/media/bhs/files/word-documents/brc/brc-flu-vac-checker-form.ashx

**ACCOMMODATION** - in chalet style accommodation which sleeps 3 people, or converted barns which sleep groups of 5 and 6 people. Chalets contain bunks and single beds. Please bring bedding or a sleeping bag, including pillows. There are deluxe accommodations available at extra costs.

**PAYMENT AND BOOKING** – please fully complete the application form and email, with a copy of your horse's flu vac history to Kim McGarva, campblackdownmendiprc@outlook.com Applications open NOW, and close on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> September 2018. Bookings are confirmed with a deposit payment of £60, or full payment, by BACS. Blackdown Riding Club, 40 17 49, 71442384 using your name and camp as reference. Kim will advise you in good time of the final amount which will be due.

## RIDERS UNDER 18 NEED AN ADULT ON SITE AT ALL

**TIMES** and non-riders must be fully paid up members of the Riding Club. Any juniors planning to come who will be in the care of an adult member who is not their parent, must provide a letter of consent from their parent.

**GUESTS** – All meals for your guests must be paid for prior to camp, no payment will be accepted on the day. You will be issued with a meal ticket, which must be handed in by your guest at the meal.

**CANCELLATION** – refunds may be possible until two weeks before closing date, thereafter charges may apply.

Please remember you will need to wear a hat and body protector, (information can be found on BRC website) which conforms to Riding Club standards (All jump lessons will require body protectors to be worn). Please read BMRC constitution regarding events and lessons www.blackdownmendiprc.co.uk/constitution. (We will be making checks so you WILL be removed should you not comply. This is beyond BMRC's control).

If you are new to the Club, or have not recently had a lesson with the Club, you may be asked to book a lesson or two in order for your riding to be assessed so we can group you correctly.
